General Weidling's panzer corps was dragged into the city in a futile attempt to prolong the existence of the Third Reich, whose leaders squabbled and schemed in their underground shelters. Dieses Buch beschäftigt sich mit den letzten Monaten des zweiten Weltkriegs auf dem europäischen Kriegsschauplatz. Es beginnt mit der alliierten Invasion im Westen im Juni 1944 und der fast zeitgleichen sowjetischen Operation Bagration im Osten und beschreibt zunächst in groben Zügen die Feldzüge der Alliierten bis zur Kapitulation Deutschlands im Mai 1945. Doch der Schwerpunkt dieses Buches soll nicht nur auf den oben erwähnten großräumigen Operationen liegen. Eine kurze Zusammenfassung dieses Kriegsverlaufs dient in der Einführung zunächst dazu, den gesamten Zusammenhang der Kämpfe darzustellen. Die großen und entscheidenden Schlachten und Gefechte auf dem deutschen Reichsgebiet werden anschließend ebenso detailliert dargelegt, wie einzelne weniger bekannte Ereignisse bei den Kämpfen um einzelne Orte und Regionen.
