What if all legends and fables told in our history were true? What if every dragon rider, and all other magical creatures did exist? Wouldn't that make our world similar to the one I've created? What better setting could there be for a youth

fantasy or YA high fantasy? Q: Lastly, how does *The Land of the Beasts* differ from your YA epic fantasy tales? *The Land of the Beasts* is written to better resemble the type of fable you'd expect to hear in an old tavern or similar setting. It lacks the heavy character development seen in *Champion's Rising*, or the ideological theme present in *The Dragons' Will*. However, it features far
