Anne Bogart is Artistic Director of the SITI Company, which she founded with Japanese director Tadashi Suzuki in 1992. She is the recipient of two OBIE Awards and a Bessie Award, and is an associate professor at Columbia University. Her recent works include *Alice's Adventures*; *Bobrauschenbergamerica*; *Small Lives, Big Dreams*; *Marathon Dancing*; and *The Baltimore Waltz*. Tina Landau, noted director and playwright, whose original work includes *Space* (Time magazine 10 Best), *Dream True* (with composer Ricky Ian Gordon) and *Floyd Collins* (with composer Adam Guettel), which received the Lucille Lortel Award for Best Musical, an OBIE Award and seven Drama Desk nominations.
