The fourteen chapters in this anthology feature original analyses of contemporary German-language literary texts, films, political cartoons, cabaret, and other types of performance. The artworks display a wide spectrum of humor modes, such as irony, satire, the grotesque, Jewish humor, and slapstick, as responses to unification with the accompanying

euphoria, but also alienation and dislocation. Kerstin Hensel's Lärchenau, Christoph Hein's Landnahme, and vignette collections by Jakob Hein (Antrag auf ständige Ausreise und andere Mythen der DDR) and Wladimir Kaminer (Es gab keinen Sex im Sozialismus) are interpreted as examples of the grotesque. The popular films Lola rennt, Sonnenallee, Herr Lehmann, NVA, Alles auf Zucker!, and Mein Führer—Die wirklich wahrste Wahrheit über Adolf Hitler are reexamined through the lens of traditional and more recent humor or comic book theories. The contributors focus on how each artwork enriches four

prominent postwall German cultural trends: post-unification identity reconstruction, Vergangenheitsbewältigung (including Hitler humor), New German Popular Literature (Christian Kracht's ironic subtexts), and immigrant perspectives (a "third voice" in the East-West binary reflected here pointedly in Eulenspiegel cartoons). To date, no other scholarly work provides as comprehensive an overview of the diverse strategies of humor used in the past two decades in German-speaking countries. *Four-Color Communism* Univ. War es ein anderes, vielfältigeres, als es der ideologisch überformte Geschichtsunterricht in der DDR bot? In ihren Beiträgen wollen die Autoren des Bandes – unter ihnen ausgewiesene Fachleute für die Geschichte des Mittelalters, für Byzantinistik, Germanistik, Skandinavistik und Zeitgeschichte – den potenziellen Beitrag

der Runkelserie zur Ausprägung des Geschichtsbewusstseins mehrerer Generationen vor allem in Ost-, aber auch in Westdeutschland ausloten und kritisch hinterfragen. Bringing together the work of an array of North American and European scholars, this collection highlights a previously unexamined area within global comics studies. It analyses comics from countries formerly behind the Iron Curtain like East Germany, Poland, Czech Republic, Hungary, Romania, Yugoslavia, and Ukraine, given their shared history of WWII and communism. In addition to situating

these graphic narratives in their national and subnational contexts, *Comics of the New Europe* pays particular attention to transnational connections along the common themes of nostalgia, memoir, and life under communism. The essays offer insights into a new generation of European cartoonists that looks forward, inspired and informed by traditions from Franco-Belgian and American comics, and back, as they use the medium of comics to reexamine and reevaluate not only their national pasts and respective comics traditions but also their own post-1989 identities and experiences.

and the Historical Imagination in the World, contributors seek to examine the many ways in which history worldwide has been explored and (re)represented through comics and how history is a complex construction of imagination, reality, and manipulation. Through a close analysis of such works as V for Vendetta, Maus, and Persepolis, this volume contends that comics are a form of mediation between sources (both primary and secondary) and the reader. Historical comics are not drawn from memory but offer a nonliteral interpretation of an object (re)constructed in the creator's mind. Indeed, when it comes to history, stretching the limits of the

imagination only serves to aid in our understanding of the past and, through that understanding, shape ourselves and our futures. This volume, the second in a two-volume series, is divided into three sections: History and Form, Historical Trauma, and Mythic Histories. The first section considers the relationship between history and the comic book form. The second section engages academic scholarship on comics that has recurring interest in the representation of war and trauma. The final section looks at mythic histories that consciously play with events that did not occur but nonetheless inflect our understanding of history. Contributors to

the volume also explore questions of diversity and relationality, addressing differences between nations and the cultural, historical, and economic threads that bind them together, however loosely, and however much those bonds might chafe. Together, both volumes bring together a range of different approaches to diverse material and feature remarkable scholars from all over the world.

 Comics als sequenzielle Bilderfolgen stellen eine Reduktion von Ereignissen auf das Wesentliche dar. Sie sind in der Lage, komplexe Themen verständlich zu präsentieren. Dennoch wird ihnen in der kognitiven Medienwirkungsforschung kaum Aufmerksamkeit geschenkt. Das Ziel der vorliegenden Studie ist es, den Comicleser kennen und verstehen zu lernen: Wie lesen Kinder eigentlich Comics? Was verstehen sie und inwieweit übertragen sie das Gelesene auf die Wirklichkeit? Im Kontext einer Befragung von

MOSAİK-Lesern zwischen 9 und 13 Jahren wird diesen Fragen nachgegangen. Dazu wurde ein Modell zum Comicverstehens entwickelt, das in den theoretischen Annahmen des Uses-and-Gratification-Approach und des Limited Capacity Model eingebettet ist. Diese Analyse leistet so einen Beitrag zur wenig ausgedehnten Forschungsliteratur bezüglich der kognitiven Verarbeitung von Comics. Die Ergebnisse haben also nicht nur wissenschaftliche, sondern auch praktische Relevanz.

As with all other forms of popular culture, comics in East Germany were tightly controlled by the state. Comics were employed as extensions of the regime's educational system, delivering official ideology so as to develop the "socialist personality" of young people and generate enthusiasm for state socialism. The East German children who avidly read these comics, however, found their own meanings in and projected their own desires upon them. Four-Color Communism gives a lively account of East German comics from both perspectives, showing

how the perceived freedoms they embodied created expectations that ultimately limited the regime's efforts to bring readers into the fold.
