Valorizar horizontes utópicos de outras formas sociais não é irrealismo ou expressão de

impotência política: é resgatar bússolas indispensáveis para direcionar e estimular lutas antigas e novas. No Brasil de Bolsonaro, o debate sobre Bem Viver, decrescimento, comuns, ecofeminismo, direitos da Mãe Terra e desglobalização, proposto neste livro, oferece oxigênio para uma esquerda que precisa se revigorar, e, principalmente, se reinventar. **** Este livro parte da

premissa de que estamos vivendo uma crise sistêmica que só pode ser resolvida com alternativas sistêmicas. As crises ambiental, econômica, social, geopolítica, institucional e civilizatória são partes de um todo. É impossível resolver qualquer uma delas sem abordar conjuntamente e as demais. Elas se retroalimentam. Por isso, estratégias unidimensionais não conseguirão	resolver essa crise sistêmica. Pelo contrário, podem agravá-la. Longe de se autoimplodir pelas próprias contradições, o capitalismo está se reconfigurando à procura de novos mecanismos para aumentar suas taxas de lucro, até extrair a última gota de sangue das pessoas e do planeta. Tudo é mercantilizável. Tudo é uma "oportunidade" para novos negócios. Não há limites. A	superexploração, o hiperconsumo e o desperdício são os motores desse sistema, que exige crescimento infinito de um planeta finito. O aumento da desigualdade e a destruição dos ciclos vitais da natureza são seu legado. No entanto, o capitalismo não é o único elemento que levou a essa crise sistêmica. O produtivismo e o extrativismo que a ele deram origem — e que
--	--	---

sobreviveram inclusive em economias que queriam superar o capitalismo — são dois fatores-chave. A ideia de uma sociedade florescente, baseada em um contínuo crescimento econômico, levou a romper com o equilíbrio climático alcançado pela Terra há onze mil anos. A isso temos de somar as estruturas e a cultura patriarcal, que sobrevive há séculos e que alimenta diferentes

formas de concentração e exercício do poder em benefício de elites privadas, tanto no espaço público como no privado. O capitalismo não criou o patriarcado, mas o acentuou de uma forma particular ao invisibilizar o trabalho reprodutivo e de cuidado que as mulheres e outros grupos humanos desenvolvem em espaços não mercantilizados. Por último, a visão

antropocêntrica dominante considera o ser humano como superior, separado da natureza e acima dela. Assim como o patriarcado considera a mulher um objeto, o antropocentrismo considera que a natureza pode ser explorada e transformada em benefício humano. Essa visão de mundo, que já existia em sociedades pré-capitalistas, cresceu exponencialmente com a

revolução industrial e os avanços da tecnologia. Portanto, quando falamos em construir alternativas sistêmicas, estamos nos referindo não apenas à superação do capitalismo, mas a estratégias que sejam capazes de enfrentar e superar o patriarcado, o produtivismo-extrativismo e o antropocentrismo. Essas alternativas não surgem no vazio. Emergem de lutas,

experiências, iniciativas, vitórias, derrotas e do ressurgimento dos movimentos sociais, e aparecem em um processo muitas vezes contraditório de análises, prática e propostas que são validadas na realidade. A diversidade de realidades que interagem em nosso planeta requer alternativas sistêmicas diversas. Por isso é que falamos em "alternativas", no plural, e que o objetivo deste livro reside em

promover um diálogo construtivo e criativo entre essas diferentes visões.

How the objective of a resource-efficient low carbon economy is to be reached and how the transition is managed are the key issues addressed by this publication. The two main focuses are industrial policy and employment prospects on the road to a green economy that retains its industrial base. Any lasting

recovery of the real economy will necessarily take the shape of a more resource-efficient production model. While we argue that only a more ambitious and comprehensive European climate policy framework would have a chance of delivering the broader 2050 climate targets, this does not mean that Europe has to give up its industrial base and its related competences. Several
