The result is a narrative laboratory for the "science of imaginary solutions" proposed by Alfred Jarry (whose King Ubu also plays a central role in the story told here), a work of fictocriticism blurring form and content, and the story of a single instant in time lost in the deserts of the intermountain west. Craig Dworkin is the author of four scholarly monographs - *Reading the Illegible* (Northwestern University Press), *No Medium* (MIT Press), *Dictionary Poetics: Toward a Radical Lexicography* (Fordham University Press), and *Radium of the Word: a Poetics of Materiality* (Chicago University Press) - as well as a half-dozen edited collections and a dozen books of experimental writing, including, most recently, *The Pine-Woods Notebook* (Kenning Editions).
