The three concepts mentioned in the title of this volume imply the contact between two or more literary phenomena; they are based on similarities that are related to a form of 'travelling' and imitation or adaptation of entire texts, genres, forms or contents. Transfer comprises all sorts of 'travelling', with translation as a major instrument of transferring literature across linguistic and cultural barriers. Transfer aims at the process of communication, starting with the source product and its cultural context and then highlighting the mediation by certain agents and institutions to end up with inclusion in the target culture. This is really two books in one: a valuable reference resource, and a groundbreaking case study that represents a new approach to constructional semantics. It presents a detailed descriptive survey, using extensive examples collected from the Internet, of German verb constructions in which the expressions *durch* ('through'), *über* ('over'), *unter* ('under'), and *um* ('around') occur either as inseparable verb prefixes or as separable verb particles. Based on that evidence, the author argues that the prefixed verb constructions and particle verb constructions themselves have meaning, and that this meaning involves subjective construal processes rather than objective information. The constructions prompt us to distribute focal attention according to patterns that can be articulated in terms of Talmy's notion of 'perspectival modes'. Among the other topics that play an important role in the analysis are incremental themes, reflexive trajectors, fictive motion, 'multi-directional paths', and 'accusative landmarks'.

philosopher Karoline von Günderode (1780–1806). The second collection of writings by the German
poet, dramatist, and philosopher Karoline von Günderode (1780–1806), Poetic Fragments was
published in 1805 under the pseudonym “Tian.” Günderode’s work is an unmined source of insight
into German Romanticism and Idealism, as well as into the reception of Indian, Persian, and Islamic
thought in Europe. Anna C. Ezekiel’s introductions highlight the philosophical significance of the
texts, demonstrating their radical and original consideration of the nature of the universe, death,
religion, power, and gender roles. The dramas “Hildgund” and “Muhammad, the Prophet of Mecca”
are two of Günderode’s most important works for her accounts of agency, recognition, and the
status of women. The three poems included in the collection, “Piedro,” “The Pilgrims,” and “The Kiss
in the Dream,” represent the wide range of forms in which Günderode wrote. They reflect themes of
erotic longing and union with the divine, and point to her radical reimagining of death. This bilingual
English-German edition is the first volume of Günderode’s work to appear in English, and will help

Permanent exclusion from school and institutional prejudice Creating change through critical
bureaucracy Anna Carlile This book tells the story of permanent exclusion from school from within
an urban children's services department. It focuses on two areas: what contributes to instances of
permanent exclusion from school, and what the effects are of its existence as a disciplinary option.
The book questions how and why local government officers make particular decisions about children
and young people. Rather than focussing on what children and young people 'did' behaviourally to
'get excluded', the book adopts a Foucauldian analysis to concentrate on their place within a larger
policy-community which includes professionals and policy makers. It adopts a critical-bureaucratic
exercise in 'studying up' on powerful organisations: an informed approach to ameliorating social
inequity. The findings described here suggest a broad, deep and opaque seam of institutional
prejudice: permanent exclusion from school can be understood to be both caused by this and to
intensify its effects. This has implications for the 'voices' of young people subject to or at risk of
permanent exclusion from school, and the final chapter outlines a Foucauldian/Freirian 'student
voice' project, offering ideas about how schools might tackle this.
