La foi du musulman Dar Al Kotob Al Ilmiyah دار الكتب العلمية

"Minhâj Al-Muslim" (La voie du musulman) comprend cinq parties, chacune se composant de plusieurs chapitres. La première est consacrée à la foi ; la deuxième au comportement ; la troisième à l'éthique ; la quatrième aux pratiques religieuses ; et la cinquième aux rapports sociaux. Il englobe ainsi les fondements et les branches de la religion musulmane. Décrivant la méthode qu'il a suivie en composant son livre, le Sheikh Abu Bakr Al-Jazâ'irî (abou bakr jaber al jazairi), que Dieu l'ait en sa miséricorde, dit : "J'ai suivi, avec l'assistance de Dieu, la bonne voie. Ainsi dans les chapitres relatifs au dogme, je n'ai pas dévié des préceptes des Anciens qui ont l'approbation unanime de la Communauté. Celui qui fait sien ce dogme est sûr d'obtenir le salut, car il est le dogme auquel adhère le Prophète (PBSL), ainsi que ses Compagnons et leurs successeurs. Ce dogme est également en adéquation avec la nature primordiale et la religion pure apportée par tous les Prophètes et pour laquelle les Livres ont été révélés. Dans la partie réservée à la jurisprudence - pratiques religieuses et rapports sociaux -, j'ai fait de mon mieux pour rechercher l'avis le plus juste et le plus valide dans les oeuvres des illustres imams (Abu Hanîfa, Mâlik, Ash-Shâfi'î et Ahmad ; Dieu leur accorde sa miséricorde) toutes les fois qu'il s'agissait d'une question qui ne s'appuyait pas sur un texte explicite ou sur un argument manifeste dans le Livre de Dieu et dans la Sunna de Son Envoyé. Ainsi, tout musulman qui suit les enseignements exposés dans ce livre est, sans aucun doute, sûr de se conformer à la loi divine. Mon dessein est de réunir dans une seule voie, nos frères pour qu'ils constituent une unité où concordent leurs idées, communient leurs âmes, et interagissent leurs sentiments".

Increasingly Islam struggles against negative stereotypes as a religion of intolerance, extremism and fear, which has failed to meet the challenges of modernity. Zidane Meriboute here proposes a fresh perspective on the crisis facing Muslims today. His novel and original approach looks to the Islamic Sufi tradition and the progressive liberal thought of the 12th century philosophers Ibn Rushd (Averroes) and Ibn Sina (Avicenna) as holding the key to a successful transition towards modernity. The humanity and questioning which both Sufism and this progressive thought engender can produce -- according to the author -- the foundations of a new Muslim worldview contrary to the current and dangerous fundamentalisms. Salafi thinkers and others who claim to be returning to an austere and ascetic interpretation of early Islam have, in Meriboute's view, hijacked their faith and produced two negative outcomes. Firstly, they have blocked the path towards the evolution of any kind of modernist thinking among Muslims. And secondly, they have created a rhetoric and encouraged events (most notoriously, 9/11) which have resulted in the demonization of their tradition. As the Muslim and non-Muslim worlds grapple to understand how Islam is likely to evolve in the 21st century, the appearance of this book, with its emphasis on the religion's progressive traditions, marks a vital contribution to a better understanding of one of today's most intractable problems.

Making the Voice of Humanity Heard Modern Guide

A schism has emerged between mainstream Islamist movements in the Muslim world (e.g. Hamas of Palestine and Hezbollah of Lebanon) and the uprooted militants who strive to establish an imaginary ummah, or Muslim community, not embedded in any particular society or territory. Roy provides a detailed comparison of these transnational movements, whether peaceful, like Tabligh Jamaat and the Islamic brotherhoods, or violent, like Al Qaeda. Neofundamentalism, he argues, is both a product and an agent of globalization.

In Europe's Ghost, Michael Radu reveals that Europe's identity crisis does not lie in past or present racism or in a variety of largely invented or anachronistic crimes, but in the self-inflicted renunciation of national traditions in favor of multiculturalism. In fact, most European elites see jihadism as nothing but a peculiar form of criminality, due to the social and economic problems inside Europe, rather than what it is: a peculiar form of warfare rooted in cultural developments imported from the Muslim world. The truth, Radu offers, is that most Muslims in most European countries see themselves as visitors, rather than as citizens of Europe. Thus, the British media's outcry over the phenomenon of British-born Muslim terrorists murdering "fellow Britons" is dangerously misplaced.

'Islamophobia' is a term that has existed since the nineteenth century. But in recent decades, argues Pascal Bruckner in his controversial new book, it has become a weapon used to silence criticism of Islam. The term allows those who brandish it in the name of Islam to 'freeze' the latter, making reform difficult. Whereas Christianity and Judaism have been rejuvenated over the centuries by external criticism, Islam has been shielded from critical examination and has remained impervious to change. This tendency is exacerbated by the hypocrisy of those Western defenders of Islam who, in the name of the principles of the Enlightenment, seek to muzzle its critics while at the same time demanding the right to chastise and criticize other religions. These developments, argues Bruckner, are counter-productive for Western democracies as they struggle with the twin challenges of immigration and terrorism. The return of religion in those democracies must not be equated with the defence of fanaticism, and the right to religious freedom must go hand in hand with freedom of expression, an openness to criticism, and a rejection of all forms of extremism. There are already more than enough forms of racism; there is no need to imagine more. While all violence directed against Muslims is to be strongly condemned and punished, defining these acts as 'Islamophobic' rather than criminal does more to damage Islam and weaken the position of Muslims than to strengthen them.
