Seit Franz Josef Hausmanns Einführung in die Benutzung der neufranzösischen Wörterbücher von 1977 haben sich bedeutende Veränderungen in der Wörterbuchlandschaft Frankreichs und anderer frankophoner Sprachgemeinschaften wie Quebec, Belgien und der Suisse romande ergeben, ebenso in den lexikographischen Techniken (z.B. die Digitalisierung) und den metalexikographischen Theorien und Beschreibungskonventionen. Das Arbeitsheft trägt einerseits diesen Veränderungen Rechnung, ohne dabei auf die Bedeutung der großen historischen Tradition der französischen Lexikographie zu verzichten,

andererseits ist es als Handbuch der französischen Lexikographie verwendbar. Entsprechend führt der Band zunächst in die Grundbegriffe der Lexikologie und Lexikographie ein, widmet sich anschließend zentralen Strukturelementen und dem Informationsangebot in lexikographischen Werken, gibt einen Überblick über die Typologie von Wörterbüchern (inkl. Lernerwörterbüchern) sowie über die wichtigsten Definitionswörterbücher und Enzyklopädien des Französischen (inkl. ihrer historischen Dimension) sowie anderer frankophoner Sprachgemeinschaften. Ein eigenes Kapitel ist der zweisprachigen Lexikographie Französisch und Deutsch gewidmet.

Dictionaries usually give only brief treatment to etymologies and even etymological dictionaries often do not lavish on them the attention which many deserve. To help fill the gap, the author deals in depth with several etymologically problematic words in various Germanic, Jewish, Romance, and Slavic languages, all of which have hitherto either been misetymologized or not etymologized at all. Sometimes, he succeeds in cracking the nut. Sometimes, he is able only to clear away misunderstanding and set the stage for further treatment. Usually, he marshals not only linguistic but also historical and cultural information. Since this book also discusses methodology, it has the

makings of an introduction to the science, art, and craft of etymology. David L.
