MEDICATION CHARTING STANDARDS As mentioned above, the Medication Administration Record (MAR) is used to document medications taken by each individual. The MAR includes

- a column which lists the names of the medications that are prescribed.
- a start date for each prescribed medication is sometimes noted and a stop date when known.

FILLING OUT MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION RECORDS Documentation of medication administration may not be delegated to NAP. Reviewing medication documentation cannot be delegated to NAP. Neither the patient nor the NAP is responsible for making this clinical judgment. The skill of patient assessment is a nursing responsibility. Understanding the basics of medication administration

Medication errors can happen anywhere along the chain of the process. Errors can occur with prescribing, documenting, transcribing, dispensing, administering and monitoring. At all these points along the chain, a nurse has to step in and double-check that everyone, from the doctor to the pharmacist, performed their job correctly.

8 Rights of Medication Administration: Medication Errors

Your documentation of medication administration must be done at the time that you give the medication. You must complete all of the documentation that is required on the medication log.

- Documentation should be done in blue or black ink.
- No pencil or white out can be used.

The final 54-item RCR instrument covers three key components of medication documentation: (1) completeness of documented information (including prescription, medication administration and pro re nata (PRN) medication), (2) quality of transcriptions and (3) compliance with chart structure, legibility, handling of deletions and chart corrections.

A complete medication order must include the client's full name, the date and the time of the order, the name of

the medication, the ordered dosage, and the form of the medication, the route of administration, the time or frequency of administration, and the signature of the ordering physician or licensed independent practitioner's signature.
