Manchmal gewinnt man, indem man ihn überrumpelt und all seine Willenskraft sammelt und sich fest vornimmt, durch alle negativen Gefühle hindurchzugehen. Dann wieder ist es wichtig zu erkennen, wann man dem Kampf aus dem Weg gehen sollte, um stattdessen mit Hilfe richtiger Pausen und echter Freizeit Kräfte zu sammeln.
