Like its two predecessors, it comes out at a key moment for European integration. In 1989 a major reform of the financial system and budget procedure had been introduced following the proposals contained in the Delors package. In 1995 a new financial framework had just been adopted for the period 1993-99, taking into account the Treaty on European Union and the accession of three new Member States. This new edition takes on board the impact of the Agenda 2000 financial framework adopted at the Berlin European Council in March 1999. A coherent set of measures has been taken to pave the way for the next enlargement and major reforms have been introduced in the biggest areas of Union expenditure - the common agricultural policy and structural operations. As this new financial framework is put in place, the European Commission is reforming its own internal workings and procedures to increase its effectiveness. One of the main strands of this reform is to modernise financial management. This should lead to more efficient financial procedures and quicker payments, as part of a general drive to make better use of taxpayers' money. The Commission's administrative reforms also include a new strategic planning system designed to ensure a closer match between activities performed and resources allocated. This entails a radical overhaul of the process for preparing the Commission's preliminary draft budget. The purpose of this publication is to provide an insight into Community public finances that, if not exhaustive, is at least wide-ranging and accurate. With its division into separate chapters and the inclusion of a detailed summary, it can also serve as a reference work. The finances of the European Union are in constant development. The system they represent is both a legacy of the past, which explains some of its complexity, and an ongoing effort to improve and adapt. Further changes will be needed in the years ahead, for example to meet the challenge of enlargement. The Intergovernmental Conference in 2004 will be an opportunity to reform the Community system of finance. Also, as this edition goes to press, a proposal for recasting the financial regulation is nearing adoption. We have therefore included a discussion of the prospects for

the future.

Many writers and artists have undertaken the difficult task of recreating the image of Lenin for their contemporaries and future generations. The Blue Notebook by the well-known Soviet author Emmanuil Kazakevich (1913-1962) has become one of the most popular books about Lenin. A notebook in a blue cover actually did exist. In it Lenin jotted down notes for his famous book State and Revolution which he worked on in the difficult days preceding the Great October Socialist Revolution. At the time Lenin was in hiding at Razliv Station, from where he directed the preparations for the armed uprising. "He was a passionate traveler, a hunter, a crack shot, a top-notch driver, the life of the party, witty and full of fun... Moreover, he was a truly courageous soldier." This portrait of Kazakevich was drawn by his contemporary and colleague, the writer Alexander Tvardovsky. During the Second World War Kazakevich, commander of a platoon, was asked to join the staff of the brigade newspaper. After working on the paper for a short while he asked to be transferred back to the front lines. "The front lines are important to me not only as a patriot, but as a writer," he said. Emmanuil Kazakevich was born in the Ukraine in 1913, the son of a teacher. His first book, a volume of poetry, was published in 1932. He translated the works of Pushkin, Lermontov, and Mayakovsky

into Yiddish. Kazakevich's first prose work, *The Star*, is a harsh, yet sensitive war story which gained him world fame. This was followed by *Spring on the Oder*, *Heart of a Friend*, *Two in the Steppe*, *The House on the Square*, *By the Light of Day* and *The Blue Notebook*, the author's last work. Kazakevich was twice awarded the State Prize for Literature.

The management of risk is a fundamental purpose of government. Under this frame of reference, risk management is not something a risk management department practices on a public body; but rather an organisational value that informs and supports all managers' and employees' duties and activities. Risk management is a central purpose of public institutions. 'Public Sector Risk Management' addresses the major challenges facing public bodies today and provides the basic tools necessary for implementing a risk management programme. It introduces the subject of risk management through the

development of a framework known as 'Organisation Risk Management' (ORM), which establishes the premise of risk management as an organisation-wide endeavour.
