Le pluralisme médical, objet du colloque que voici, traverse les sociétés africaines qui sont désormais prises dans les mailles de la mondialisation et du multiculturalisme. Jusqu'à un passé très

récent, pour des raisons historiques évidentes, la problématique du pluralisme médical en Afrique semblait se réduire à l'opposition de la médecine moderne (ou occidentale) et de la médecine dite traditionnelle (ou africaine). Mais, ces dernières décennies, avec l'implantation chinoise en Afrique et l'essor des mouvements pentecôtiste et charismatique, l'offre thérapeutique s'est diversifiée ainsi que la demande. Dans les villes, une urbanisation mal maîtrisée dans un contexte général de précarité économique et d'insécurité, occasionne la cohabitation des nganga se réclamant de la tradition avec des "charlatans", des thérapeutes spirituels, des prestataires chinois, etc., tandis que l'institution médicale au succès indéniable, mais encore inaccessible à beaucoup et souvent inhospitalière, alimente l'automédication. Dans les campagnes, l'abandon des malades à leur sort favorise la résurgence des soins à base de plantes. Les contributeurs de ce colloque sont des historiens, des psychiatres, des médecins, des infirmières, des tradipraticiens, des anthropologues, des sociologues, des philosophes,

etc. En rassemblant autour d'une même table et d'un même sujet des compétences aussi diverses, on a misé sur la fécondité du croisement des perspectives, même si la part belle est faite aux anthropologues et aux sociologues. En outre, cet ouvrage est un bouquet offert à Eric de Rosny, jésuite et anthropologue, qui scrute le pluralisme médical au Cameroun depuis quelques décennies. Women have long been crucial to the provision of medical services, both in the treatment of sickness and in maintaining health. In this study, Susan Broomhall situates the practices and perceptions of women's medical work in France in the context of the sixteenth century and its medical evolution and innovations. She argues that early modern understanding of medical practice and



authority were highly flexible and subject to change. She furthermore examines how a focus on female practitioners, who cut across most sectors of early modern medical practice, can reveal the multifaceted phenomenon of these negotiations for authority. This new paperback edition of Women's medical work in early modern France skilfully combines detailed

research with a clear presentation of the existing literature of women's medical work, making it invaluable to students of gender and medical history. Promoting, as it does, more in-depth research into the intricacies of Greek medical writings and their diverse revival and transformation from the fifth century BC down to the fourteenth century AD, this volume will be of interest to classicists,

medical historians and anyone concerned with the reception of the Greek medical tradition.
