This book was the result of a symposium held at the American Chemical Society meeting in Miami Beach, Florida, September 10-15, 1989. The symposium was jointly sponsored by The Society for Economic Botany and the American Chemical Society Food and Natural Product sub division. There were five speakers. During the social sessions (mostly over drinks in a hotel room), it became obvious that, regardless of the discipline, we were all speaking the same language. That is, the field of Natural Products is broad, but similar in techniques and approach, ancient but modern, and has been and continues to be extremely valuable to humankind. We wanted the book to serve as an introductory text for courses and as a reference work for the future. We also determined to include the structure of every chemical in the chapter where it was mentioned so the reader would not have to find the structure somewhere else or to try and deduce the structure from the chemical name. Little did we know what an undertaking these goals would be or the time this would take.

This volume offers a survey about what is known about the Ancient Egyptians' vision of the afterlife and an examination of these beliefs that were written down in books that were later discovered in royal tombs. The contents of the texts range from the collection of spells in the Book of the Dead, which was intended to offer practical assistance on the journey to the afterlife, to the detailed accounts of the hereafter provided in the Books of the Netherworld. The author looks closely at these latter works, while summarizing the contents of the Book of the Dead and other widely studied examples of the genre. For each composition, he discusses the history of its ancient transmission and its decipherment in modern times, supplying bibliographic information for any text editions. He also seeks to determine whether this literature as a whole presents a monolithic conception of the afterlife. The volume features many drawings from the books themselves.

Totenbuch-Forschungen khalid siddiqui

This volume contains the proceedings of the twenty-third Annual Egyptological Colloquium, held at the British Museum in 2014, augmented by additional papers. The twenty-three contributions investigate functionality, iconography and manufacture of ancient Egyptian coffins from the First Intermediate Period to the eighth century AD. The authors explore the conceptual aspects which lay behind the production of coffins through the study of iconography and texts, examining the functional role of these complex objects as 'structured compositions' which were designed to play an important part in transforming the deceased occupants and perpetuating their existence beyond death. Reinstating coffins in their archaeological and societal contexts, the papers reflect on the circumstances in which they were made, considering workshop practices and regional variability, and studying coffins not only individually but also as components of larger conceptual entities in which the mummy, the burial chamber and the tomb itself all had specific meanings. Several contributions focus on areas of current interest, such as the post-burial adaptation and reuse of coffins, considering how these issues relate to the economic environment in which they were made and to changing attitudes towards the immutability of burial arrangements.

The Mummy's Foot Cornell University Press

Owing to their unique state of preservation, mummies provide us with significant historical and scientific knowledge of humankind's past. This handbook, written by prominent international experts in mummy studies, offers readers a comprehensive guide to new understandings of the field's most recent trends and developments. It provides invaluable information on the health states and pathologies of historic populations and civilizations, as well as their socio-cultural and religious characteristics. This interdisciplinary handbook will appeal to academics in historical, anthropological, archaeological and biological sciences, and will serve as an indispensable companion to researchers and students interested in worldwide mummy studies.

Mit Irmtraut Munro geht Anfang 2009 eine der produktivsten Forscherinnen zum altägyptischen Totenbuch in den Ruhestand. In den vergangenen 15 Jahren erschien im Harrassowitz-Verlag ein Dutzend Monographien von ihr zu diesem Thema. Die Festschrift versammelt 17 Aufsätze befreundeter Wissenschaftler und Kollegen aus insgesamt 10 europäischen Ländern. Dem Hauptinteresse der Jubilarin entsprechend bilden Publikationen und Studien zu einzelnen Textzeugen des Totenbuchs einen inhaltlichen Schwerpunkt des Buches. Weitere Beiträge befassen sich mit ihrer Ikonographie, Überlieferungsgeschichte sowie ihrem Inhalt und ihren Vignetten. Einige Beiträge gehen über den Bereich des Totenbuchs hinaus und nehmen Bezug auf weitere Texte wie das Mundöffnungsritual und die Pyramidentexte. Insgesamt behandelt das Buch ausgewählte Fragen zum Totenbuch über seinen gesamten Belegzeitraum vom Neuen Reich bis zur Ptolemaerzeit.

Im September 2005 richtete das Bonner Totenbuch-Projekt eine interdisziplinäre Konferenz aus, deren Beiträge in diesem Band zusammengestellt sind. Die 27 oft reich bebilderten Aufsätze umfassen eine Vielfalt von Themen: Publikationen bislang unbekannter Handschriften auf den unterschiedlichsten Textträgern, Untersuchungen einzelner Texte oder Darstellungen aus dem Totenbuch, das Totenbuch als Quelle zu ausgewählten religionswissenschaftlichen Themen, Beginn und Ende der Totenbuch-Überlieferung und allgemeine Beobachtungen zum Totenbuch (zur Bezeichnung des Verstorbenen als Osiris, zur Palaographie, zur Anordnung der Vignetten, zu Totenbuch-Vignetten auf den Sargen der Dritten Zwischenzeit, zu Amulett-papyri). Darüber hinaus präsentieren fünf Restaurierungswissenschaftler den aktuellen Forschungsstand zu sachgemässer Konservierung und Aufbewahrung von Papyri, zur Lesbarmachung stark nachgedunkelter Schrift, zu verwendeten Farben und möglichen Falttechniken.
