Written sometime in the first two-thirds of the fourth century BCE, the *Hedupatheia* was widely read in the late classical and early Hellenistic periods and was translated into Latin by Ennius, through whom it influenced the work of later Roman poets including Horace. It survives today in fragments totalling about 330 lines. The *Hedupatheia* is a fundamental source for our understanding not only of fourth-century literature but also of the significance of food and dining and the reception of epic

poetry in late classical society.
