Hans Scharer was born at Wadenswil (near Zurich), Switzerland, in 1904. After his school years, he was trained for (Protestant) missionary work at the Missionshaus in BiHe. For seven years, 1932-1939, he lived among the Ngaju in southern Borneo; first with the Ngaju speaking people of the Katingan river area, later, for a shorter period. with those living along the Barito. He was granted European leave in 1939, and spent the years 1939-1944 studying Ethnology (as it then was called) under Professor J.P.B. de Josselin de Jong at Leiden University. He went home to Switzerland in 1944, but returned to Leiden in 1946 to complete his studies and defend his Ph. D. thesis on *Die Gottesidee der Ngaju Dajak in Süd-Borneo*. It is this thesis which. published by E.J. Brill, Leiden, in 1946, is now being re-issued in English translation. Soon after, he left once more for the Ngaju territory, as Praeses of the Baseler Mission in south Borneo. He died there suddenly on December 10th, 1947, of blood-poisoning. These few biographical data are not merely of some slight historical interest: they help us to understand the man and his work. The present book is Scharer's only major work to have been published, and for Scharer himself it was, in a way, an experiment.

Buku ini menunjukkan besarnya peran memori kolektif untuk eksistensi dan pewarisan maen pukulan di masa depan. Selain itu, terlihat relevansi memori kolektif dengan pembentukan identitas serta perkembangan tradisi Betawi seiring zaman. Buku ini bermanfaat untuk pemerhati dan peneliti sosial dan budaya, praktisi dan pengelola perguruan silat, serta masyarakat pecinta tradisi.

Secrets of Kalis Ilustrisimo Alprin

Tidak dapat dipungkiri, dilihat dari tinggalan seni dan budaya, etnis Betawi terbentuk dari hasil akulturasi beberapa etnis yang pernah mendiami daerah yang kini menjadi ibu kota Republik Indonesia ini. Melalui evolusi yang panjang, proses peleburan beberapa etnis itu terjadi, sehingga melahirkan etnis dan kebudayaan baru, terlepas dari kebudayaan induk yang mempengaruhinya. Dalam perkembangannya, Maen Pukulan atau pencak silat khas

Betawi, menjadi bagian terpenting dalam kehidupan bermasyarakat, menjadi identitas ke-Betawi-an yang bersanding dengan kehidupan beragamaan, sehingga lahir ungkapan sholat dan silat. Sholat dan silat merupakan personifikasi sederhana masyarakat Betawi dalam mengaplikasikan ajaran Islam tentang “hablum minnallah dan hablum minannas”, bagaimana menjalin hubungan antara hamba dengan Sang Penciptanya dan memelihara hubungan antar sesama dan makhluk lainnya. Seiring perjalanan waktu yang mengubah pola kehidupan masyarakat dan gencarnya arus globalisasi, Maen Pukulan atau pencak silat khas Betawi semakin terpinggirkan. Keberadaannya tidak lagi menjadi bagian penting dari kehidupan masyarakatnya. Hal ini pula yang menjadi penyebab degradasi pelestarian dan pengembangan beberapa aliran Maen Pukulan satu

persatu hilang ditelan zaman. Buku yang ditulis anak Betawi ini tidak hanya menyajikan riwayat aliran-aliran Maen Pukulan Betawi yang dikumpulkan melalui tuturan lisan, tetapi juga ulasan yang dirangkum dari beberapa sumber sejarah tertulis.
