Fought on 19 May 1643 between the French army of the Duc d'Enghien and the Spanich army under Francisco de Melo, Rocroi is probably one of the most controversial battles in the long period of conflict between the kingdoms of France and Spain. The numerous sources, be they official accounts, memoirs, or correspondence, most often contradict each other. The principal controversy of this battle, far from being anecdotal, concerns the French right flank, placed under the direct command of Louis II de Bourbon, the Due d'Enghien. The version generally accepted by historians of French sources affirms that the cavalry of Gassion overthrew and quickly pushed back the first Spanish companies, eventually defeating them. However, Spanish sources, defended by historians beyond the Pyrenees, contend that the cavalry of the Due d'Albuquerque, opposing that of Gassion and Enghien, broke through the squadrons and two infantry regiments of the French advanced guard on two occasions! Thus, there exist today two battles of Rocroi: the one found in Spanish works and the one found in numerous French works. Reconstructing a global vision of the battle remains a delicate undertaking. For this reason and to avoid any dubious interpretation, it seemed necessary to Stephane Thion to include numerous quotations

to illustrate the unfolding of this battle. A great study with splendid military paintings and pictures. Book jacket.

Ferdinand Foch ended the First World War as Marshal of France and supreme commander of the Allied armies on the Western Front. Foch in Command is a pioneering study of his contribution to the Allied victory. Elizabeth Greenhalgh uses contemporary notebooks, letters and documents

from previously under-studied archives to chart how the artillery officer, who had never commanded troops in battle when the war began, learned to fight the enemy, to cope with difficult colleagues and allies, and to manoeuvre through the political minefield of civil-military relations. She offers valuable insights into neglected questions: the contribution of unified command to the Allied victory; the role of a commander's general staff; and the mechanisms of command at corps and army level. She demonstrates how an energetic Foch developed war-winning strategies for a modern industrial war and how political realities contributed to his losing the peace.

Alexander Werth est l'un des rares correspondants de guerre à se rendre à Stalingrad au lendemain de la capitulation allemande, quelques jours seulement après la fin des combats qui opposèrent l'armée soviétique à l'armée allemande. Ainsi, en plus de livrer un témoignage très personnel et très fort de la situation sur place dès 1943, l'auteur revient sur le déroulement précis, d'un point de vue militaire, de ce qui fut le tournant de la Seconde Guerre mondiale : depuis l'offensive allemande sur Stalingrad de l'été 1942, jusqu'à la contre-offensive victorieuse de l'armée soviétique lancée le 19 novembre 1942. devenue une bataille mythique ? Comment a-t-elle influé sur la manière dont l'armée soviétique s'est transformée au cours de ces mois décisifs de l'hiver 1942-1943 ? De l'original en langue anglaise publié sous le titre *The Year of Stalingrad* en 1946 chez Hamish Hamilton à Londres, la traduction présente réunit les chapitres consacrés exclusivement à la bataille de Stalingrad, qui forment le cœur de l'ouvrage, le premier à paraître sur le sujet.
