It brings out a new approach to the role of the body in art, not as a speculative object or symbolic material but as the living source of the imaginary. This second volume reporting on the excavations at the site of the 'Unexplored Mansion' describes all the structures and finds that are later than Minoan. The substantial deposits that range between Minoan and Hellenistic are mainly pits, wells and wash levels with little remaining of

the buildings with which they were associated; for the Hellenistic and Roman periods, until the third century AD, there are substantial remains of a succession of buildings.

These provide a context for the large quantity of finds whose description takes up the bulk of the report.
