erfüllen müssen, um als pädagogisch
 wertvoll gelten zu können. Die Arbeit ist
 im Hauptteil in zwei Teile gegliedert. Im
 ersten, theoretischen Teil meiner
 Abfassung möchte ich zunächst die
 entwicklungs- und lerntheoretischen
 Grundlagen erläutern. Bei den
 entwicklungstheoretischen Grundlagen zur
 mittleren Kindheit konzentriere ich mich
 auf Piagets Entwicklungstheorie, der mit
 seiner umfassenden Theorie des Denkens
 und der Intelligenz die
 Entwicklungspsychologie auf dem Gebiet
 der kognitiven Entwicklung stark geprägt
 hat. Der lerntheoretische Abschnitt
 beginnt mit einer Darstellung vom Begriff
 des Lernens, bevor ich auf die drei
 klassischen Lernparadigmen und das
 Verständnis von Medien in ihren
 Konzepten eingehe. Der letzte Abschnitt
 des Theorieteils hat zum Ziel über die
 Darstellung der Dimensionen von Medien,

des computerunterstützten Lernens und der Typisierung von Lernsoftware und Computerspielen, eine Definition darüber zu geben, was als Lernportal verstanden werden kann, wie es in die Medienlandschaft einzuordnen ist und was seine charakteristischen Merkmale und Vorteile sind. Der zweite, praktische Teil meiner Arbeit beginnt mit einer Aufstellung von Kriterien, die der Bewertung eines Lernportals dienen können. Diese Kriterien habe ich zu einem Bewertungsbogen zusammengefasst, den ich exemplarisch auf zwei ausgesuchte Lernportale, „scoyo“ und „Karlchen Krabbelfix“ anwenden möchte. Zunächst folgt eine Beschreibung des jeweiligen Lernportals, die aus einer Kurzbeschreibung und einer ausführlicheren Darstellung besteht. In der ausführlichen Darstellung sind beispielsweise Informationen zu den Preisen, der Aufgabengestaltung oder die Einflussmöglichkeiten von Eltern und Lehrern, erläutert. Hier habe ich überwiegend Informationen zusammengefasst, die ich auf den jeweiligen Plattformen finden konnte. Nach dem Vorstellen des Portals habe ich eine Bewertung mithilfe des Bewertungsbogens vorgenommen. Die Ergebnisse meiner Analyse sind dann in einer abschließenden Zusammenfassung über jedes Portal zu finden. Im Schlussteil möchte ich mithilfe meiner Ergebnisse aus dem theoretischen und dem praktischen Teil eine Antwort auf die genannte Leitfrage geben, welche Voraussetzungen ein Lernportal meiner Meinung nach erfüllen sollte, um als pädagogisch wertvoll gelten zu können.
