This book is a selection of photographs of the artist himself, friends (dead and alive), relatives, and the wooden boy (soon to be a real boy) Pinocchio. Jim Dine is attempting in these works to bring, through memory, to life the people around him now and from the past. He has found a way to put aside mortality by the way the camera continually lies.

Jim Dine's status as a master draughtsman is unquestioned and this book presents the best of his most recent drawings. Hello Yellow Glove opens with one of Dine's most treasured motifs, Pinocchio. Using dense charcoal and dripping washes, Dine depicts the sinister edge to Carlo Collodi's story and Pinocchio's isolation in his quest to become a real boy. With similar dark layers and dissolving forms Dine also depicts botanical motifs such as the thistle and catalpa tree. In addition to these bodies of work, Hello Yellow Glove presents Dine's portrait of Gerhard Steidl, an ambitious suite of nine drawings made

by the artist in his Göttingen studio.

Alongside reproductions of the drawings are photographs of Dine taken by Steidl during the sittings, which form both a candid portrait of the artist and offer a rare glimpse into his working processes. Born in 1935 in Cincinnati, Ohio, Jim Dine is a prolific painter, draughtsman, print-maker and photographer. Initially associated with the Pop movement, Dine's career spans over forty years and his work is held in many private and public collections. His books with Steidl include *Birds* (2001), *The Photographs, so far* (2003) and *Hot Dream (52 Books)* (2008). *Hello Yellow Glove* Bantam

In tandem, he weaves the racing 911's rich history, where it reigned victorious at Le Mans, Daytona and many more of the world's most prestigious races. With more than 350 pages and 300 vivid color and black and white photographs, this amazing hard-cover book showcases why the 911 continues to impress enthusiasts and engineers alike. Leffingwell interviewed dozens of former and current Porsche engineers, designers and executives - including Ferdinand "Butzi" Porsche, the father of the 911 - as well as Porsche competitors (who used the 911 as a benchmark for their own designs) to create a true, hands-on anecdotal history of the 911. Straight from the key

players and decision-makers, he explains: "This book is an inside story of how the 911 came to be what it was, what it is now and how it moved through 40-plus years of evolution, growth and improvement." A jaw-dropping and unprecedented collection of 911s between two covers (Leffingwell and David Newhardt's stunning, full-page, color photography features more than 80 Porsche 911s) complements the text, enticing readers to an up-close-and-personal view of these exotic, wish-list cars.

A superbly designed volume on the father of participatory sculpture The interrelationship of media and the participatory component of art are central to this career-spanning monograph of the work of German artist Franz Erhard Walther (born 1939). Proceeding from his earliest works, his Word Images, brightly colored monochrome works, to his influential First Work Set presented at the revolutionary Spaces show at MoMA in 1969, one of the earliest artworks designed to be manipulated by the public and on to his large scale textile works from the 1970s to now that combine

aspects of performance, painting, sculpture and architecture, *Shifting Perspectives* demonstrates how Walther has pioneered intermedia and participatory art. This beautiful volume reflects the colorful textile materials that Walther picked up from pop art and has used throughout his career, with special colored page edges and a clothbound cover.

The analysis continues with the launch of the E-type in 1961, through its model history and motor sport achievements until production ceased in 1975, and the legacy that has influenced various Jaguar designs ever since.

Bright, colorful and minimalist, Michael Craig-Martin's paintings and sculptures tackle the semiotics of everyday objects. Michael Craig-Martin (born 1941) is an important figure in British Conceptual Art, and among the most influential artists and teachers of his generation. Since his rise to prominence in the late 1960s, he has moved between sculpture, installation, painting, drawing and print, creating works that fuse elements of Pop, Minimalism and Conceptual Art. His work transforms everyday objects--from buckets and ladders to sneakers, mobile phones and laptops--with bold colors and simple, uninflected lines. Renowned as an art educator, he has inspired generations of artists, most notably the Young British Artists (YBAs). This handsome book, the

MICHALIS PICHLER es el primer libro/monografía centrado en la práctica del artista y autor radicado en Berlín Michalis Pichler. El libro está editado por Annette Gilbert y Clemens Krümmel. La publicación explora un cuerpo de

publicaciones de artista y otras obras de Pichler que hace un uso estratégico de material encontrado y usado previamente, incluidas fuentes derivadas de imágenes, objetos, sonidos, textos o pensamientos. Su subtítulo más bien largo se deriva de una publicación de Lucy-Lippard : Trece años: La materialización de las ideas de 2002 a 2015: un libro de información de referencia cruzada sobre algunos límites estéticos: compuesto por una bibliografía en la que se insertan textos, ensayos críticos, obras de arte, documentos, ordenados cronológicamente y centrados en los llamados "greatest hits" y poética conceptual con menciones de áreas tan vagamente designadas como apropiación, post-ingenuidad, inaburrimiento aburrido, détournement, objet perdu, poesía borrada o escritura a través, que ocurren ahora en el trabajo de Michalis Pichler (con matices políticos ocasionales) , editado por Annette Gilbert y Clemens Krümmel. La obra monográfica sirve como un proyecto de artistas híbridos en el espíritu de los catálogos de Martin Kippenberger, con escritos que abordan elementos de la práctica artística de Pichler, una sección de catálogo ampliamente ilustrada y

elementos intercalados que podrían llamarse información primaria. Como un estudio de las obras creadas durante la última década, la publicación también es una reflexión sobre la naturaleza de la canonización y el efecto del catálogo de artista al colocar la obra del artista (es decir, la de Pichler) dentro de un linaje o narrativa histórica, así como el lugar del objeto libro en la afirmación de la importancia de la contribución de los artistas al campo en general. Como el cuerpo de trabajo que se presenta para su consideración está interesado en estos límites de autoría y autenticación, el "catálogo" se convierte en una reflexión sobre la construcción del yo artístico. La publicación incluye 11 ensayos críticos, un catálogo de obras ampliamente ilustrado, una conversación con el artista John Stezaker, así como escritos seleccionados del artista, que brindan una introducción a la poética conceptual. Otros ensayos críticos incluyen los de Tobias Amslinger, Matthias Bleyl, Eleanor Brown, Craig Dworkin, Annette Gilbert, Mark Gisbourne, Patrick Greaney, Jean-Claude Moineau, Ariane Müller, Stefan Ripplinger, Magnus Wieland. Intercalado a lo largo del libro

está la serie de collages de migración, de una manera que hace que el libro sea un híbrido entre una monografía propiamente dicha y un libro de artista.
