Hammer's German Grammar and Usage Simon and Schuster Cuban culture has long been available to English speakers via translation. expression in the original Spanish. In addition to the dynamics at work in the choices translators make at the level of the text itself, this study attends to how paratexts like prefaces, footnotes, liner notes, and promotional copy shape the audience's experience of the text.
