'Teaching Tip' which explains the spelling rule being covered on that page (if there is a spelling rule). Children are then presented with a list of words to learn that follow the relevant spelling rule. Each word is presented with a colorful, child-friendly image. (Note: a minority of pages have no images, such as for High Frequency words). Logical Teaching Sequence Graphemes / spelling patterns are introduced in a logical sequence, based on a combination of factors: 1) how difficult the spelling patterns are to learn. 2) the need to give children at least one way of phonetically representing each sound in the English language. 3) how often each spelling pattern occurs in the English language. Also high frequency words are covered separately from other words. Structured Teaching Sequence Children are only introduced to one new grapheme at a time. For example, the word 'wrong' would not be used to teach the pattern -ng if the spelling pattern of wr- had not been taught previously.
