Though Blackwood wrote a number of horror stories, his most typical work seeks less to frighten than to induce a sense of awe. Good examples are the novels *The Centaur*, which climaxes with a traveler's sight of a herd of the mythical creatures; and *Julius LeVallon* and its sequel *The Bright Messenger*, which deal with reincarnation and the possibility of a new, mystical evolution in human consciousness.
