Should schools attempt to cultivate patriotism? If so, why? And what conception of patriotism should drive those efforts? Is patriotism essential to preserving national unity, sustaining vigorous commitment to just institutions, or motivating national service? Are the hazards of patriotism so great as to overshadow its potential benefits? Is there a genuinely virtuous form of patriotism that societies and schools should strive to cultivate? A series of seven lectures prepared for a French audience and delivered by the author in the winter of 1908-1909 at the University of Paris, to relate those ideas that seem vital, significant, and creative in the life and character of the American people. The lectures included: The Soul of a People; Self-reliance and the Republic; Fair Play and Democracy; Will-power, Work and Wealth; Common Order and Social Cooperation; Personal Development and Education; and Self-expression and Literature. Henry van Dyke (1852-1933) was an American clergyman, educator, and author. He graduated from Princeton in 1873, and from Princeton Theological Seminary in 1874. He was pastor of the Brick Presbyterian Church, New York City (1883-99), professor of English literature at Princeton (1899-1923), and U.S. minister to the Netherlands (1913-16). Among his popular inspirational writings is the Christmas story *The Other Wise Man* (1896). As President Wilson's ambassador to the Netherlands from 1913, Van Dyke was a first-hand witness to the outbreak of World War I and its progress, and was a key player in the President's diplomatic efforts to keep the U.S. out of the conflict.
