Fray Mocho

(Gualectuaychú, 26 de agosto de 1858 - Buenos Aires, 23 de agosto de 1903) es el seudónimo de José Seferino Álvarez, escritor y periodista argentino famoso por sus retratos costumbristas y

de época, frecuentemente escritos en clave humorística. Nació en Gualectuaychú, provincia de Entre Ríos Argentina el 26 de agosto de 1858, hijo de padres criollos.
