a much-needed historical overview of French cinema from its roots through to the political and social developments in the 1990s and beyond. **France's Lost Empires** Peter Lang Luis Buñuel (1900-1983) was one of the truly great film-makers of the twentieth century. Shaped by a repressive Jesuit education and a bourgeois family background, he reacted against both, escaped to

Paris, and was soon embraced by André Breton's official surrealist group. His early films are his most aggressive and shocking, the slicing of the eyeball in *Un Chien andalou* (1929) one of the most memorable episodes in the history of cinema. The *Forgotten Ones* (1950) and *He* (1952), made in Mexico, were followed, from 1960, in Spain and France, by the films for which he is best known: *Viridiana* (1961), *Belle de jour* (1966), *Tristana* (1970), *The Discreet Charm of the Bourgeoisie* (1972), and *That Obscure Object of Desire* (1977). Gwynne Edwards analyses the films in the context of Buñuel's personal obsessions - sex, bourgeois values, and religion - suggesting that the filmmaker experienced a degree of sexual inhibition surprising in a surrealist. have become familiar with highly acclaimed films from the Romanian New Wave such as 4 Months, 3 Weeks and 2 Days (2007), The Death of Mr. Lazarescu (2005), and 12:08 East of Bucharest (2006). However, the hundred or so years of Romanian cinema leading to these accomplishments have been largely overlooked. This book is the first to provide in-depth

analyses of essential works ranging from the silent period to contemporary productions.
