In the late eighteenth century, French émigré priests fled the
religious turmoil of the French Revolution and found themselves
leading a new wave of Roman Catholic missionaries in the United
States. *Fathers on the Frontier* explores the diverse ways these
missionary priests guided the development of the early American
church in Maryland, Kentucky, Louisiana, and other pockets of
Catholic settlement throughout much of the trans-Appalachian
West. Over the course of their evangelistic endeavor, this
relatively small group of priests introduced Gallican,
ultramontane, and missionary principles to a nascent institutional

church prior to the immigration of millions of European Catholics in the nineteenth century. As author Michael Pasquier shows, this transformation of American Catholicism did not come easily. Several generations of French priests struggled to reconcile their romantic expectations of missionary life with their actual experiences as servants of a foreign church scattered throughout a frontier region with limited access to friends and family members still in France. As they became more accustomed to the lifeways of the American South and West, French missionaries expressed anxiety about apparent discrepancies between how they were taught to practice the priesthood in French seminaries and what the Holy See expected them to achieve as representatives of a universal missionary church. At no point did French missionaries engage more directly in distinctively American affairs than in the religious debates surrounding slavery, secession, and civil war. These issues, Pasquier argues, compelled even the most politically aloof missionaries to step out of the shadow of Rome and stake their church on the side of the Confederacy. In so doing, they set in motion a strain of Catholicism more amenable to Southern concepts of social conservatism, paternalism, and white supremacy, and strikingly different from the liberal, progressive strain that historians have usually highlighted. Focusing on the collective thoughts, feelings, and actions of priests who found themselves caught between the formal canonical standards of the church and the informal experiences of missionaries in American culture, *Fathers on the Frontier* illuminates the historical intersection of American, French, and Roman interests in the United States.

Véritable précis d'ingénierie pédagogique qui s'inscrit dans une double continuité par rapport à l'ouvrage *Comment concevoir un enseignement ?* : préciser les bases théoriques de l'ingénierie pédagogique et fournir de nombreux exemples pour soutenir sa mise en oeuvre. Les auteurs proposent une théorie fondée sur les trois actes : l'acte d'apprendre à l'école, l'acte d'enseigner et l'acte de concevoir un dispositif d'enseignement-apprentissage. S'appuyant sur les recherches les plus récentes en psychologie cognitive, en psychologie de l'apprentissage et en résolution de problèmes, cette théorie établit le lien entre les approches didactiques, centrées sur l'analyse des savoirs à enseigner, et les approches pédagogiques, centrées sur les activités à proposer aux élèves. Autrement dit, comment s'y prendre pour faire apprendre sachant ce qu'est "apprendre". L'ouvrage propose ensuite 11 applications dans des domaines et des niveaux d'enseignement très diversifiés (l'histoire au collège, le système de numération au lycée, le calcul littéral en IUT, la résolution de problèmes de mécanique pour préparer un concours...).

Ancient Greece was the model that guided the emergence of many facets of the modern sports movement, including most notably the Olympics. Yet the process whereby aspects of the ancient world were appropriated and manipulated by sport

authorities of nation-states, athletic organizations and their leaders as well as by sports enthusiasts is only very partially understood. This volume takes modern Greece as a case-study and explores, in depth, issues related to the reception and use of classical antiquity in modern sport, spectacle and bodily culture. For citizens of the Greek nation-state, classical antiquity is not merely a vague "legacy" but the cornerstone of their national identity. In the field of sport and bodily culture, since the 1830s there had been persistent attempts to establish firm and direct links between ancient Greek athletics and modern sport through the incorporation of sport in school curricula, the emergence of national sport historiographies as well as the initiatives to revive (in the 19th century) or appropriate (in the 20th) the modern Olympics. Based on fieldwork and unpublished material sources, this book dissects the use and abuse of classical antiquity and sport in constructing national, gender and class identities, and illuminate aspects of the complex modern perceptions of classicism, sport and the body. This book was previously published as a special issue of the International Journal of the History of Sport.
