Il était très important à l'époque de suivre les consignes et d'éviter les zones interdites car dangereuses. Ce guide n'a pas été conçu pour de simples visites, mais comme un « véritable pèlerinage »,

un « hommage à la mémoire des héros tombés pour la France ». La richesse des documents ne manquera pas de passionner le visiteur qui parcourt les champs de bataille aujourd'hui. Elle offre un éclairage inédit sur chaque région, et permet de constater l'évolution des paysages, là où l'urbanisme et la nature ont effacé toutes les traces de cette guerre.
