One major by-product of the aging baby-boom generation has been a surging interest in cosmetic surgery. In recent years, many new anesthetic protocols have been developed to reduce the incidence of PONV and other complications, while ensuring that effective

pain management and level of 'un-awareness' during surgery is always maintained.
