Revenge of the Saguaro Egmont Books (UK)

As both a championship fiddler and superb teacher, Carol Ann Wheeler brings all her talents to bear in this fiddling book written especially for young children. Students raised in the Suzuki tradition will immediately take to the method, concepts, and techniques used in this book. Common folk songs familiar to the student are used to demonstrate and teach the basic skill of old-time fiddle playing. All melodies are first presented in their simplest form followed by more complex variations with introductions, ornaments, and endings. Students of all levels will find challenging material in this book. Younger students can proceed at their own pace, returning to the more difficult variations at a future time.

This volume builds on the techniques explained in Children's Fiddling Method Volume 1. While created with children in mind, this book is equally well suited for adults, violinists, and string teachers. What sets this method apart from others is that the tunes will first be played slowly, unaccompanied, so that you can hear the notes and how the tune goes. Then, an arrangement follows which is more up to tempo with backup. All of the tunes

will be broken down into parts for easier learning, and new fiddling techniques will be explained as they are introduced. Often, different versions will be offered for the same tune, providing variety and a way to learn more concepts, skills, and ideas that can be used in other tunes. The goal is to play along with the two included CDs. Special features of this volume are some optional twin fiddle parts and tips on twin fiddling. These pieces are great for teachers to use with students or for students to play with friends.

For most kids, catching fireflies is a fun summer activity. For twelve-year-old Serwa Boateng, it's a matter of life and death. That's because Serwa knows that some fireflies are really adze, shapeshifting vampires from the forests of Southeastern Ghana. Adze prey on the blood of innocents, possessing their minds and turning them into hulking monsters, and for generations, slayers like Serwa and her parents have protected an unknowing public from their threats. Serwa is the best adze slayer her age, and she knew how to use a crossbow before she could even ride a bike. But when an obayifo (witch) destroys her childhood home while searching for a drum, do Serwa's parents take her with them on their quest to defeat her? No. Instead, they dump Serwa with her hippie aunt and cryptic-obsessed cousin in the middle of Nowheresville, Maryland "for her own safety." Now, instead of crossbows and battle armor, she's dealing with mean girls and algebra, and for the first time in her life she doesn't have to carry a staff everywhere she goes, which is . . . kind of nice, actually. Just as Serwa starts to get the hang of this whole normal girl who doesn't punch vampires every day thing, an adze infiltrates her school. It's up to her to whip some of her classmates into monster-fighting shape before all of them become firefly food. And when she uncovers a secret that upends everything she thought she knew about her family's role in the slayer vs. adze war, Serwa will have to decide which side of herself--normal girl or slayer--is the right one. After all, seventh grade is hard enough without adding vampires to the mix. John Tyrrell's biography of the Leos Janáček is the culmination of a life's work in the field. It stands upon his existing documentary studies of Janáček's operas and translations of other key sources and his examination of thousands of still unpublished letters and other documents in the Janáček archive in Brno. Altogether it provides the most detailed account of Janáček's life in any language and offers new views of Janáček as composer, writer, thinker and human being. Volume 1, which goes up to the outbreak of the First World War and Janáček's sixtieth birthday in the summer of 1914, consists of chronological chapters providing a straightforward account of Janáček's life year by year and another forty contextual chapters. Topics include on-going sequences ('Music as autobiography I', etc.; 'Janáček's knowledge of opera I', etc.) and individual chapters on Janáček as a teacher, as a theorist, as a music ethnographer, on his speech-melody theory, his relationship to particularly influential operas (Tchaikovsky's *Queen of Spades*, Charpentier's *Louise*), on his mentors (such as Antonín Dvořák) and his *bêtes noires* (such as Karel Kovarovic). A particular feature are the specially commissioned chapters on Janáček's health by Dr Stephen Lock (one of the editors of the *Oxford Illustrated Companion to Medicine*, OUP 1994 and 2001, editor of the *British Medical Journal*, 1975-91, and a Janáček enthusiast since the early

postwar broadcasts on the Third Programme), and on Janáček's earnings and finances by Dr Jirí Zahrádka (curator of the Janáček archive in Brno, and editor of authentic editions of *Sárka* and *The Excursions of Mr Broucek*).
