Bezug auf ihre gesprochensprachlichen Phänomene, andererseits die Überprüfung, inwieweit diese Charakteristika in Mundart-Comics im Vergleich zur Umgangssprache verwendet werden. Bei dem Vergleich der Figuren- und der Erzählebene konnte sowohl in dem umgangssprachlichen Comic als auch in den Mundart-Fassungen die typische Zweiteilung in mehr geschriebensprachliche

Formen für die Erzählerrede und mehr gesprochensprachliche Formen für die Figurenrede" festgestellt werden. Dementsprechend wurden auf der Erzählebene zwischen drei und sechs und auf der Figurenebene zwischen zehn und 22 verschiedene gesprochensprachliche Phänomene eingesetzt. In dem Erzähltext waren die Merkmale der Oralität vor allem in dem Bereich der Lexik und der Morphologie zu beobachten. In den

Dialogen konnten in allen fünf untersuchten Comics die für mündliche Kommunikation typischen kurzen Sätze, die fast ausschließlich aus ein oder zwei Silben bestanden, sowie eine hohe Anzahl Partikeln ermittelt werden. Weiterhin wiesen die Sätze der Figurenrede entgegen der Annahme, dass die Autoren beziehungsweise die Übersetzer bestimmte Phänomene bevorzugen, aus allen sprachlichen Bereichen Charakteristika auf. Dennoch konnten für

jede Comic-Variante auch beliebtere" Stilmittel ausgemacht werden. Somit fanden sich im umgangssprachlichen Comic "Der Sohn des Asterix" überwiegend im Bereich der Syntax gesprochensprachliche Charakteristika, wie die Ausklammerung oder der Einsatz asyndetischer Nebensätze mit Verbzweitstellung. Im ruhrdeutschen Comic Asterix sein Ulligen" konnten die am häufigsten verwendeten gesprochensprachlichen Phänomene sowohl im Bereich der Phonetik/Graphematik, der Morphologie/

Morphosyntax als auch der Syntax ermittelt werden. Zu finden waren primär Kontraktionen und Apokopen sowie Dativ-Possessiv-Konstruktionen, die Verwendung des Akkusativs anstelle des Dativs und Satzkonstruktionen mit dem Adverb wo als Relativpronomen. Gesprochensprachliche Elemente ließen sich im pfälzischen Mundart-Comic Em Asterix soi Bobbelsche" vor allem auf der Ebene der Phonetik/Graphematik, wie Apokopen und
