Brett Anderson came from a world impossibly distant from rock star success, and in *Coal Black Mornings* he traces the journey that took him from a childhood as 'a snotty, sniffy, slightly maudlin sort of boy raised on Salad Cream and milky tea and cheap meat' to becoming founder and lead singer of Suede. Anderson grew up in Hayward's Heath on the grubby fringes of the Home Counties. As a teenager he clashed with his eccentric taxi-driving father (who would parade around their council house dressed as Lawrence of Arabia, air-conducting his favourite composers) and adored his beautiful, artistic mother. He brilliantly evokes the seventies, the suffocating discomfort of a very English kind of poverty and the burning need for escape that it breeds. Anderson charts the shabby romance of creativity as he travelled the tube in search of inspiration, fuelled by Marmite and nicotine, and Suede's rise from rehearsals in bedrooms, squats and pubs. And he catalogues the intense relationships that make and break bands as well as the devastating loss of his mother. *Coal Black Mornings* is profoundly moving, funny and intense - a book which stands alongside the most emotionally truthful of personal stories.

Los pacientes con fallas en la narcisización, las patologías narcisistas, tienen una indudable presencia en la clínica actual. En la sociedad presente, el modelo dominante retoza desenfrenadamente en el atropello de los valores éticos y culturales, y se transforma en el patrón que se ha de remedar. El contexto, frecuentemente, funciona como un caldo de cultivo para que el narcisismo de cada sujeto resulte convulsionado. Ahora bien, si nos preguntásemos por qué las patologías narcisistas fueron despertando un incesante interés tanto en la clínica como en la teoría psicoanalítica, y por qué la aparición de estos cuadros en la nostalgia psicoanalítica ha sido posterior a Freud, deberíamos concluir, como él mismo lo afirmó, que en los comienzos el cuerpo teórico y clínico del psicoanálisis sólo podía dar cuenta de las llamadas "neurosis de transferencia". Por lo tanto, a aquellos cuadros clínicos que no generaban una transferencia el método les era inaplicable. Diferentes esquemas teóricos han comprobado que esta conclusión era desacertada, y fueron estos cuadros precisamente los que forzaron el ensanchamiento del campo del psicoanálisis. Freud, se decía, no tenía elementos teóricos para explicar estos cuadros clínicos "dificultosos", que no tuvieron cabida dentro de su modelo metapsicológico y, por lo tanto, no resultaba posible abordarlos terapéuticamente. Diversos autores (Winnicott, Fairbairn, Balint, Kohut, Green, McDougall, Roussillon, Aulagnier, etc.) ampliaron y modificaron conceptos centrales de la teoría "oficial". Fue así como comenzaron a aparecer nuevas concepciones acerca de la técnica y la

metapsicología, que muchas veces perfeccionaron las clásicas y otras se apartaron de ellas. Los cuadros fronterizos, por ejemplo, son un cabal muestra de cómo determinadas patologías han influido en el desarrollo de esas nuevas nociones que debemos seguir revisando.
