Grossman's powerful anti-totalitarian works liken the Nazis' crimes against humanity with those of Stalin. His compassionate prose has the everlasting quality of great art. Because Grossman's major works appeared after much delay

we are only now able to examine them properly. Alexandra Popoff's authoritative biography illuminates Grossman's life and legacy.

 The relations between memory and history have recently become a subject of contention, and the implications of that debate are particularly troubling for aesthetic, ethical, and political issues. Dominick LaCapra focuses on the interactions among history, memory, and ethico-political concerns as they emerge in the aftermath of the Shoah. Particularly
