 In den letzten Jahrzehnten sind zahllose Bücher erschienen, in welchen der Tod Hitlers am 30.04.1945 in seinem Führerbunker so dargestellt wird, wie er von seinen Gefolgsleuten, den meineidigen Zeugen, dargestellt und von unkritischen Historikern, Buchautoren und Journalisten akzeptiert wurde. Und es sind auch zahlreiche Bücher erschienen, in denen eine Flucht Hitlers und ein jahrelanges Überleben Hitlers in sicherer Entfernung vor der Rache der Alliierten behauptet wurde. Unsere Recherchen haben eine mit hochgradiger Wahrscheinlichkeit erfolgte Verschwörung im Führerbunker aufgedeckt. Am 30.04.1945 wurde in Hitlers Bunker der letzte Akt einer von langer Hand geplanten Verschwörung inszeniert, der zahllose Historiker, Journalisten, Buchautoren auf den Leim gegangen sind, weil nicht vorurteilsfrei recherchiert wurde, sondern die wohlfeilen Informationen der angeblichen Zeugen, welche das Kapitel Hitler abschließen halfen, gern entgegen und für bare Münze genommen wurden. Von wissenschaftlichem Herangehen bei diesem Gegenstand historischer Forschung kann in Deutschland kaum die Rede sein. Wissenschaftlich gerungen wurde nur zu den Fragen: Hat sich Hitler erschossen oder vergiftet oder gar beides? Hat sich Hitler selbst umgebracht oder ließ er sich dabei helfen? Ist Hitlers Leiche völlig zu Asche verbrannt (spurlos, oder, wie passend, bis auf für eine Identifizierung wichtige Bestandteile seines Gebisses) oder blieb eine verkohlte Leiche übrig? Kaum ein Historiker ließ auch nur den geringsten Zweifel daran zu, dass Hitler am 30.04.1945 von eigener Hand verstarb. Die Verschwörung hätte jedem ernsthaft herangehenden Forscher auf die Füße fallen müssen, so offensichtlich war sie aufgrund fehlender Beweise für Hitlers Tod und aufgrund der widersprüchlichen und vielfach nachweisbar falschen Aussagen der Zeugen. Wir konnten aufgrund unserer Untersuchungen nachweisen, dass Hitler nicht am 30.04.1945 und auch nicht im Bunker starb, dass ihm offensichtlich die Flucht gelungen war, ob nun bald darauf in sicherer Entfernung zu sterben, damit seine Leiche nicht als die Hitlers erkannt werden konnte oder ob vor einer Verurteilung zu fliehen, weil die Verschwörung weit größere Dimensionen hatte. Auf jeden Fall sind die bisherigen Darstellungen von Ort und Zeit des Todes Hitlers ganz offensichtlich falsch. Die Bunkerverschwörung war ein komplizierter und raffiniert eingefädelter Kriminalfall. Heute, 70 Jahre danach ist der Fall durch unsere Arbeit aufgeklärt worden.

How close did Hitler come to his dream of developing nuclear weapons? What evidence is there for the design, testing and production of such weapons, and their carrier systems? Appendices provide the most up-to-date research on a variety of topics, including the small number of craft Japan was developing to carry atom bombs, and the Soviet capture of German nuclear research centres in the Baltic region at the end of the war. Throughout, the author is keen to only rely on the most reliable sources, and lays many myths to rest in the process. The result is a truly compelling and groundbreaking work.

In mid-1943 Nazi Germany entered a crisis from which it was to emerge vanquished. Faced with a shortage of manpower in armaments factories, the Third Reich sent concentration camp prisoners to work as slaves. While the genocide of the Jews and the Gypsies continued at extermination camps, numerous outside "Kommandos" were set up in the vicinity of the large concentration camps. The Dora Camp, located in the center of Germany, was one of the most notorious. Originally a mere Kommando attached to Buchenwald, it became one of the largest Nazi concentration camps. These prisoners were put to work in a huge underground factory, building V-2 rockets, the secret weapon developed by German scientists in an attempt to reverse the course of the war, under the direction of Wernher von Braun. He has utilized all available documents as well as unpublished testimony from several dozen fellow prisoners. He recounts the horrors of everyday life at Dora—prisoners dying by the hundreds and indescribable suffering—and the murderous "evacuation" of the camp by railroad convoys and death marches, which took place in early 1945 and led to the death of thousands of prisoners. Following on from the success of volume 1, Friedrich Georg's second book in the series covers unconventional short- and medium-range weapons. In particular, this volume includes a wealth of information about the V-rocket programme, not just the more familiar V-1 and V-2, but special variants of these two rockets as well as later experimental craft and weaponry. Following a fascinating examination of pre-war efforts to build flying bombs, the author examines the V-1 and V-2 projects in great detail. Particular attention is paid to special variants that have previously received little coverage. These include the V-2 A-4 'America Rocket', and V-2s designed to carry nuclear and radiological warheads. The capability of the Germans to deploy such weapons is also discussed. A large number of weird and wonderful projects that never left the drawing board are examined, including the FR-35, V-6, V-101, Waterfall and Naval EMW A-7 rockets. The fascinating final section examines German plans to utilise such rocketry against London and Paris in 1945, as well as recounting the activities of V-weapons on other fronts, including Italy, Yugoslavia and the Eastern Front. The text is supported by b/w photographs and 16 superb pages of colour artwork, including profiles, computer-generated images of designs that never flew, and pictures of the author's own models.

By the spring of 1943, after the defeat at Stalingrad, the writing was on the wall. But while commanders close to the troops on Germany's various fronts were beginning to read it, those at the top were resolutely looking the other way. This seventh volume in the magisterial 10-volume series from the Militärgeschichtliches Forschungsamt [Research Institute for Military History] shows both Germany and her Japanese ally on the defensive, from 1943 into early 1945. The final part follows the fortunes of Germany's ally fighting in the Pacific, Burma, Thailand, and China, with American forces capturing islands ever closer to Japan's homeland, and culminates in her capitulation and the creation of a new postwar order in the Far East. The struggle between internal factions in the Japanese high command and imperial court is studied in detail, and highlights an interesting contrast with the intolerance of all dissent that typified the Nazi power structure. Based on meticulous research by MGFA's team of historians at Potsdam, this analysis of events is illustrated by a wealth of tables and maps covering aspects ranging from Germany's radar defence system and the targets of RAF Bomber Command and the US 8th Air Force, through the break-out from the Normandy beachhead, to the battles for Iwo Jima and Okinawa.
