Diese Arbeit beschäftigt sich mit genau diesen Aspekten und klärt außerdem, ob es sich bei Fatih Akins Verfilmung um eine gelungene Adaption von Herrndorfs Roman handelt. Unser Bildungssystem sieht vor, ein möglichst breites Spektrum an Wissen in den verschiedensten Bereichen zu vermitteln.
