Over the last few
decades, historians of
scientific ecology have
brought to light the
role of the European
scientists who have
laid the basic
cornerstones of
modern ecology
between the end of the
eighteenth century and
the beginning of the
twentieth century. The
foundations of
geobotany were laid by
Alexander von
Humboldt (1769-1859),
Augustin-Pyramus de
Candolle (1778-1841),
Alphonse Jules Dureau

de la Malle
(1777-1857), Gaston
Bonnier (1853-1922)
and Charles Flahault
(1852-1935);
biocenotics, by
Erasmus Darwin
(1731-1802), Charles
Lyell (1797-1875),
Pierre-François
Verhulst (1804-1849),
Charles Darwin
(1809-1882), Karl
Moebius (1825-1908),
Charles Valentine-Riley
(1843-1895), and
François-Alphonse
Forel (1841-1912);
agrochemistry and
microbiology by Justus
von Liebig
(1803-1873), Jean-
Baptiste Boussingault
(1802-1887), and
Stanislas Winogradski
(1856-1953); the
taxonomy of
communities by August
Heinrich Grisebach
(1813-1879), Anton
Kerner von Marilaün
(1831-1898), Alphonse

de Candolle (1806-1893), and Charles Flahault; and anthropogeography by Karl Ritter (1779-1859), Elisée Reclus (1830-1905), and Friederich Ratzel (1844-1904). Together, they created the conditions that, with Eugenius Warming (1841-1924), gave birth to the autonomous discipline of scientific ecology, thirty years after the German biologist Ernst Haeckel (1834-1919) had christened this new branch of biology. Up to now, the writings of these scientists have been scattered in various publications that were often not accessible, which made a comparative study almost impossible. There was thus a need to bring together the primary sources in

their original form, pagination, and language (whenever possible, a version of the text has been made available in a second language as well). They are gathered here in two volumes, in an analytical framework that aids in understanding their relevant historical context and significance. To deal with the complex multidisciplinary roots of the history of ecology, Pascal Acot has brought together a group of historians with authoritative knowledge of the field's various sub-branches, without ever losing sight of ecology's relationship to the broader history of biology and the environmental sciences.

 cross-disciplinary
 approach to the study
 of late medieval books
 and book production in
 Paris, from the
 troubled years of the
 early fifteenth century
 onwards. It shows the
 extent to which such
 activity was able to
 flourish even against
 the backdrop of the
 endemic struggle
 between Burgundians
 and Armagnacs, or the
 subsequent English
 invasion which led to
 Agincourt and the
 regency of Bedford.
 Extensive coverage is
 given to the key role
 played by the libraire,
 to the author as scribe
 or copyist (Christine de
 Pisan, Jean Lebegue),
 and also to the
 development of

commercial production under figures such as Jean Trepperel. A section on bibliophiles and their various commissions leads into a group of essays that focus on particular texts and authors, whilst a further section concentrates on what we can discover about the role of the scribe. The volume concludes with four essays offering insights into the work of particular artists and illuminators. The authors include scholars from the UK, France, Greece, Germany, Italy, Belgium, the Netherlands and the USA. Godfried Croenen is Lecturer in French at the University of Liverpool. Peter Ainsworth is Professor of French at the University of Sheffield.

This conference was organised by the Third World Academy of Sciences in collaboration with the Canadian International Development Agency. For the 250 female scientist participants from distant lands and diverse cultures from the Caribbean to the Far East, the conference proved a stimulating experience to recognize their strength in terms of numbers and achievements, to forge new links, nationally and internationally, and to demonstrate that science is independent of gender and is no longer an exclusively male-dominated preserve. The first part of the proceedings deals with the global, Third World

and national perspectives of the theme “Women and Science” and the second highlights the scientific contributions by Third World women scientists, their personal experiences and scientific reports. The publication of these proceedings would serve as a potentially effective strategy aimed at enhancing the status of women scientists, not only in the Third World but worldwide.

The Lesser Gods of the Sahara Lavoisier

A fascinating aspect of the study of music in medieval Islamic and Judaic writings is the broad and interdisciplinary nature of the works and treatises in which it is covered. In addition, such works verbalize an art that was transmitted orally and

took shape spontaneously, typically with improvisation during performance. As a result of this outlook the musical concept (or science) is often intertwined with practice (or history). This second collection by Amnon Shiloah brings together twenty-two studies exemplifying such multi-faceted viewpoints on the world of sounds and its virtue. The first studies concern the origin and originators of music and to how its essential constituents came into being; included here is the art of dance along with the controversial attitudes towards it. Next comes the symbolic, philosophical and metaphorical interpretation of music; one of the major ideas

epitomizing this approach claimed that the pursuit of knowledge is the path to human perfection and happiness. There follow studies on the transmission of knowledge, along with some annotated key works dealing with therapeutic effects. The last articles focus on cultural traditions elaborated on European soil developing a particular style and musical practice, centred on the Iberian Peninsula, which was the scene of one of the most fascinating examples of cultural interchange.

Earthen architecture constitutes one of the most diverse forms of cultural heritage and one of the most
