She was a blonde bombshell in the style of her heroine and role model Marilyn Monroe. She was a Playmate of the Year and the sultry Guess jeans model. She married the 89-year-old multimillionaire Howard Marshall II in 1994. Then just fourteen months later he was dead and the subsequent legal fight over his estate made headlines around the world. She was Anna Nicole Smith and this is the story of her meteoric rise from a fried chicken waitress in rural Texas to one of the most photographed women in the world, culminating in her untimely death at the age of thirty-nine.
