(1944-1951). As a country that had seen a series of dictatorships following its independence from Spain, Arévalo's 1944 election is considered by historians to be the first fair and democratic election in Guatemala's republican history. Arévalo's administration was marked by unprecedentedly relatively free political life during his six-year term. An educator and philosopher, he understood

the need for advancement in individuals, communities, and nations by practical means. "It appears to be a truism today that anything touching upon US-Latin American policy is bound to end either in histrionics or hysteria, whether of the Left or Right.
