Im Prinzip haben Sie nicht unrecht, denn was in der Geschichte nicht geschah, ist doch wohl eher was für die Belletristik! Tatsächlich aber zeigen die Gedankenspielerien des Was-Wäre-Wenn, welche geschichtliche Geschehen für den Fortgang der Geschichte die Primären waren und welche eher sekundär. "Der Was Wäre Wenn Atlas" ist ein fünfbändiges Kompendium, welches die gesamte menschliche Zivilisationsgeschichte aufbereitet wie sie auch hätte ablaufen

können, wäre sie an gewissen Punkten nur etwas anders abgelaufen. Einzigartig in dieser Gattung sind in ihm Landkarten vordergründig.
