In his Port-Royal, Sainte-Beuve pictured Bayle as one of the avowed skeptics in Montaigne's funeral cortege and spoke of both men as "d'autant plus fourbes qu'ils ne le sont pas toujours." His later works show that he revised his opinion on each somewhat, I but in this he was unusual for his century.
