Leeson contends that pirates exemplified the virtues of vice--their self-seeking interests generated socially desirable effects and their greedy criminality secured social order. Pirates proved that anarchy could be organized. Revealing the democratic and economic

forces propelling history's most colorful criminals, *The Invisible Hook* establishes pirates' trailblazing relevance to the contemporary world.
